CITY IN NATURE

SICC has planted and transplanted trees and plants in the golf courses to help conserve and restore biodiversity by providing habitats for all wildlife.



SUSTAINABLE LIVING

SICC has eliminated conventional single-use plastic consumption. All food waste at Island Clubhouse is digested into liquid waste. Use of golf irrigation system that monitors and manages our water consumption.



ENERGY RESET

SICC provides EV chargers in the Clubhouse to encourage more electric car users. The Club is also in the midst of installing solar panels at the Island Clubhouse.



RESILIENT FUTURE

SICC has an on-site herb & vegetable garden that grows basic vegetables like blue pea, pandan, lime leaf, local mint, curry leaf, lemongrass, chilli padi and thai basil for use in our F&B outlets, i.e., Island Bistro.



GREEN GOVERNMENT

SICC is working on the implementation of an uncertified internal carbon reduction policy to align our business units with our sustainability goals and objectives, as a first step to ensure the Club is moving in the right direction.
