

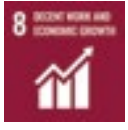


OUR SUSTAINABILITY JOURNEY

Members of the United Nations (UN) pledged to implement 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) - a shared blueprint for advancement of a sustainable, inclusive, and just society.

SICC has aligned our sustainability journey with these SDGs. To date, SICC has gathered 125 sustainable initiatives (50 are current and ongoing, while 75 are planned). These initiatives contribute to 9 UNSDGs and 22 UNSDGs targets.
